



Estampe dans la ville (Prints in the city)

From March 29 to October 6th, 2013, contemporary printmaking will dominate the historic center of **Dreux** in France. Walking through the city, one will discover exhibits and demonstrations in three different places; more than 40 artists working in printmaking will be presented. They are members of the association "Graver maintenant", or invited guests.

The first exhibit takes place at the **Museum of Art and history** in March, with an exhibit of "Painted portraits, printed portraits". The second opening takes place at the **Ar[T]senal**, a regional contemporary art center, where a panorama of printmaking will take place, presented by six different themes. The third part of this itinerary will take place in the **Chapel of the Hôtel-Dieu** with a French/Quebec show ("12 prints done by 4 hands") and a selection of artists' books.

These overlapping exhibits will be completed by conferences, workshops and guided visits.

The curators of these shows are: Ar[T]senal and Chapelle de l'Hôtel-Dieu: Catherine Gillet and Anne Paulus, under the direction of Franck Augustin, head of the Ar[T]senal, and Axelle Marin, head of the Museum of Art and History.
